MACD is a non-governmental, nonprofit 501 (c) (3) organization established to represent and provide services to Michigan's 79 Conservation Districts

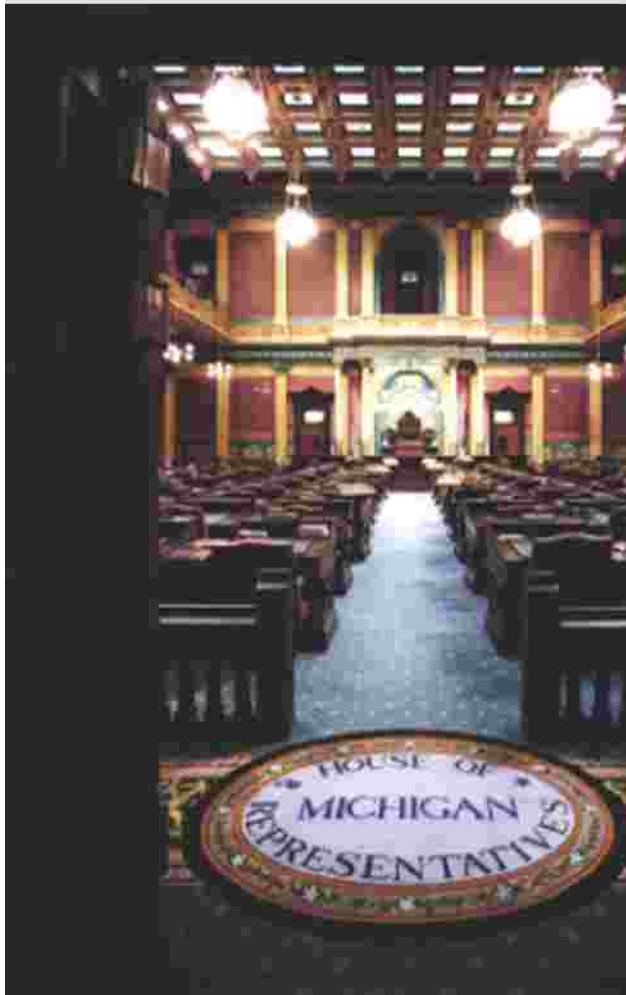
